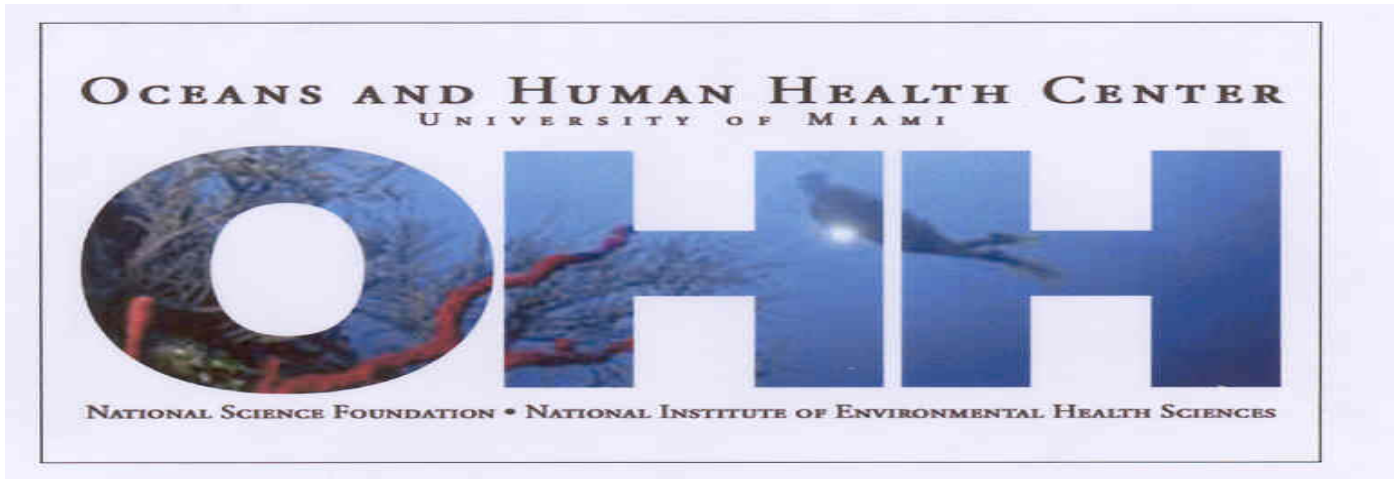


PLEASE SAVE THE DATES!
